RULES FOR 700 CLUB TOURNAMENT

1. All tournament bowlers must be Adult members of the Twin Cities USBC and the National 700 Club of America. If a bowler needs to join the National 700 club, there is a one-time fee of \$20.00, Plus local 700 Club dues, which are paid annually, of \$5.00.
2. This Tournament is a certified tournament with the United States Bowling Congress and the Twin Cities USBC Association.
3. This is a scratch tournament, and all bowlers must use their final highest average, based on a minimum of 21 games, for the 2024-25 season. Any bowlers not having a 2024-25 average must use their current highest average for the 2025-26 season, based on 21 games or more. If you have a Challenge and/or Sport Bowling Average, your average will be adjusted according to USBC rule (201c)
4. Rule 319d and 319e will be in effect for all bowlers.
5. Current Average 10 Pin Rule is in effect!
6. Bowlers will bowl 4 (four) games across 8 (eight) lanes. All bowlers will be assigned their starting lane at time of check-in.
7. Entries will be limited to a one-time entry. Entries Close May 8th, 2026
8. Prize fund will be returned 100% on a 1 for 4 bases in each division.
9. There will be 5 (five) divisions in this tournament; AA Division – 206 average and above, A Division - 205 average and below, BB Division - 206 average and above (Age 55 and over), B Division – 205 average and below (Age 55 years of age and over), and C Division - Age 70 years and over. Bowlers must decide at the point of check-in, which division they will bowl in.
10. Optional Doubles Divisions. Two Divisions - Division I – 411 and above combined average. Division II – 410 and below combined average. Bowlers can bowl with up to three different bowlers during the same shift. Entry fee for this event will be \$10.00 per doubles team (Prize Fund - \$9.50, Expenses - \$0.50). Each division with a payout of 1 to 5 ratios.
11. Entry fee will be a total of \$30.00 (Lineage - \$12.00, Expenses - \$2.00, Prize Fund - \$11.00, Local Dues - \$5.00) and paid with cash or check only. **ALL CHECKS RETURNED WILL BE CHARGED \$ 35.00!**
12. Night Shift times will be 7:00 PM Each Night – Check-in starts at 6:00 PM. There is No Night Shift on Thursday, May 7th 2026. There will be Two Special Afternoon Shifts at 1:00 PM. On Tuesday, May 5th 2026, and Thursday, May 7th 2026.
